***CITY COUNCIL PRESIDENT ASKS DOES THE CITY HAVE MONEY FOR YOU?***

*Pittsburgh...* Next Thursday, the City of Pittsburgh is sending a list to the state of 500 residents that are due amounts ranging from \$2 to \$18,000. Check the link on City Council's website <http://www.city.pittsburgh.pa.us/council/> to see if your name is listed. If your name appears contact Council President Harris's Office at 412.255.2135 to verify if these funds are for you and not for someone else who shares a name with you.

Unclaimed money, by law, must be turned over to the appropriate state governments. Fortunately, City Council President Darlene Harris has pushed for a more proactive attempt in returning this money to the rightful owners. This cash belongs to ordinary people like you.

Proof of ID may be necessary, such as a copy of driver's license or another form of government-issued photographic identification. Listed residents will have until 4pm, next Thursday, April 12, 2012 to claim the funds before it is forwarded to the state.

If you can prove you are entitled to the money, we will gladly return it to you. Are you one of these people?
