For Hearing and Action agenda items, the Planning Commission requests those who wish to testify in-person please pre-register by 9:00 am the morning of the meeting by sending an email to <u>planningcommission@pittsburghpa.gov</u>. Please identify which agenda item for which you intend to testify. At the meeting, the Commission Chair will call for public testimony for Hearing and Action items.

  - o Provide testimony at the public speaker podium when called.
- If providing testimony via Zoom:
  - o Join the virtual meeting and use raise hand function to request to speak.
  - Call into the meeting on your phone and use raise hand function by pressing \*9.
