

## **MELLON TENNIS COURT RULES**

- Pay online at the time of booking occasional court time. Office: 412-665-4017
- Enter the facility using the revolving door closest to your court assignment. Please do NOT congregate on Court 1.
- Wait until the end of a point before crossing courts.
- Absolutely NO carts, hoppers, or any other container filled with tennis balls are allowed to be brought into the tennis dome. Patrons can bring a maximum of 2 cans of tennis balls per court. Ball carts can be rented at the office for \$3 per hour.
- Ball machines can be used, but require a ball cart rental at \$3 per hour.
- Please return demo rackets on the same day that you borrow them.
- Do NOT ask another group to move to another court. Mellon staff will make final decisions on court assignments.
- Unused courts are NOT open for free play. Violators will be charged for the court time.
- As a courtesy to other players, please keep the noise level down.
- No more than 4 players on the court at one time, except for pre-authorized clinics.
- Absolutely NO gum, food, coffee, soda or glass permitted: water ONLY.
- Properly dispose of all trash in the receptacles provided at each court.
- NO smoking or vaping allowed in the tennis facility or office.
- Proper clothing and footwear required, including shirts. NO black soled shoes.
- Clean up court 5 minutes prior to the end of your time. Playing or cleaning your court past your reservation will result in additional charges and/or loss of right to use the facility.
